

Medolac Product Label Barcode Configuration

Medolac® uses **GS1 Barcode Standards and Global Trade Item** Number for its product labels. GS1 Barcode Standards are recognized as providing multiple benefits to hospitals and healthcare institutions through improved product traceability and inventory management.

The GS1-compliant 2D Data Matrix is printed on each product and case label. The 2D Data Matrix consists of six pieces of information for Product, and seven pieces of information for Case identification:

1. **GTIN Number**: (Case/Product)

A 14-digit number comprised of the indicator number, GS1 company prefix, 3-digit item reference number, and check digit. The GTIN number is a unique identifier of the product code.

2. **Serial Number**: (Case/Product)

A number representing the serial identity of the Case or Product.

3. **Expiry**: (Case/Product)

Expiry date of the Case or Product Lot.

4. **Lot Name**: (Case/Product)

Name of manufactured Lot of the Product, or Products in Case.

5. **Calories**: (Case/Product)

Calorie count of specified Product.

6. **Serving Size**: (Case/Product)

Serving Size of the specified Product.

7. **Products In Case**: (Case/Product)

Comma separated serial numbers of all the product pouches present in specified case.
